- Staged! Conservatory classes have been postponed until April 28th.
- ART EDU continues to work on its residency program with the Vancouver School of Arts and Academics. ART will be offering online workshops and classes in playwriting, Shakespeare, Meisner, clowning and movement, and acting styles.
- In accordance with guidance issued by the Oregon Higher Education Coordinating Commission, PAC has suspended all in-person classes through April 28th. They will be continuing their Two-Year Conservatory classes virtually during the month of April. All Adult Evening classes have been postponed. They are still holding auditions and interviews for the Conservatory Program. They will not be conducting in-person auditions and interviews until it is safe to do so.
